



The Historic Hotel Pez Espada in Torremolinos is expanding with the construction of a new annex.

**The new building will consist of five floors, 30 Junior Suites and a garden area.
Work commenced in September 2016 and will finish June 2017.**

MedPlaya, the hotel chain who own the hotel, have invested €5.2 M in this Project and in improvements.



The Hotel Pez Espada in Torremolinos is growing with a new annex building which will accommodate 30 suites and a garden area.

MedPlaya Hotels have invested 5.200.000 euros in the improvements and expansion of the Hotel Pez Espada, Torremolinos, which was declared a Property of Cultural Interest in 2006. The aim of these improvements is to modernise the hotel, whilst at the same time ensuring the well-being and comfort of its guests. The main activity is the construction of a five-story building annexed to the hotel, with a total of 30 Junior Suites and a garden area. The façade of 60 rooms has also been refurbished.

With this extension the hotel will offer a total of 235 rooms and create new job opportunities.

All Junior Suites, measuring 42.50m², have a terrace of 10.05m². Some also enjoy a private garden. They will be equipped with fibre optics and will offer free Wi-Fi, modern shower and a hydro massage bath with led's situated on

the terrace. The furniture and all installations (32" LED Smart TV, porcelain flooring ...) are designed to offer maximum comfort to guests.

Having obtained the relevant licenses and the favorable resolution of the Ministry of Culture of the Junta de Andalucía, work on the new building began in September 2016, and is scheduled to be completed by mid-June 2017. Throughout the construction, sustainability and the environment remain of the utmost importance. "We are committed to offer modern hotels with services our guests expect and which are also more sustainable. The new building operates aerothermal energy system, a source of renewable energy (75% clean energy consumption) which uses the heat of the surrounding air, to cool and heat each room and sanitary water", explains the Project manager, Daniel Colomer.

In addition to the construction of the new annex building, modifications are taking place within the main building of the Pez Espada. Included in this project is the creation of a "splashpark" making the pool area even more fun for families.

The Pez Espada Hotel is adapting to current times but continues to retain the essence and character of an historical building. It was inaugurated on May 31, 1959 and represented the launch of tourism in the Costa del Sol. In fact, its construction is an icon of what was then called "relax in style". From the very start this iconic hotel attracted illustrious guests, amongst them: Ava Gardner, Sophia Loren, King Albert II of Belgium, Brigitte Bardot, Frank Sinatra and Orson Welles and many more. The Hotel Pez Espada has also hosted performances by famous artists such as Raphael, Massiel or Rita Pavone

About MedPlaya

MedPlaya is a hotel chain based in Girona which specialises in the management of tourist establishments in popular beach destinations. Founded in 1967 on the Costa Brava, its expansion began in Benidorm and continued along the Costa del Sol, Salou and Maresme with the purchase of several hotels, including the historic Pez Espada Hotel in Torremolinos (Malaga). The group has a turnover of more than 83 million euros (in 2016) and a workforce of 1,450. During 2017 Med Playa celebrates its 50th anniversary.
